WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees is in receipt of a confidential memorandum from Special Counsel Sean Gallagher of Clark Hill PLC concerning the status of the Retirement System’s “mezzanine” loan, along with the Police and Fire Retirement System of the City of Detroit, in the ICG Leaseback Fund I, LLC investment (“Leaseback”); and

WHEREAS, AXA Equitable Life Insurance Company (“AXA”), the first priority lender in Leaseback, has requested, through counsel, that both the Retirement Systems, in addition to the borrower, ICG Leaseback Fund I, LLC (the “Borrower”), authorize release of escrowed lease payments; direct use of \$7.5 million of those escrowed lease payments for use as the “Tenant Reserve Requirement” under the loan documents; and provide wire instructions for transferring the remainder of the escrowed funds to the Retirement Systems; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to release and receive its portion of escrowed lease payment funds from Leaseback; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been advised by the Executive Director and General Counsel in this matter, and

WHEREAS, the Board has considered this matter in open session;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board, expressly contingent on similar authorization by the Police and Fire Retirement System of the City of Detroit, authorizes release of escrowed lease payments related to Leaseback (i) to first satisfy the Tenant Reserve Requirement under the Leaseback loan documentation; (ii) to next release remaining funds to the Retirement Systems; and (iii) authorizes the Executive Director,

General Counsel and Special Counsel, to communicate the necessary wire information to AXA, and take other actions necessary to effectuate this Board action; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution will be forwarded AXA, Lou Vogt, Special Counsel, and the Police and Fire Retirement System of the City of Detroit.

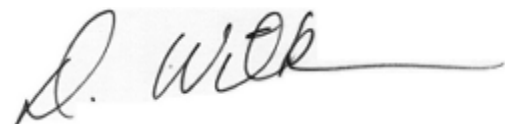
