ASSISTANT EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR **DAVID CETLINSKI** INFORMED THE BOARD OF **KASSELL JAMES'** JANUARY 13, 2017 REQUEST TO BE INSTATED AS A VESTED MEMBER OF THE DETROIT POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 20, 1986 THROUGH JANUARY 15, 1996. **MR. CETLINSKI** ALSO ASKED THE BOARD TO ADOPT A RESOLUTION UPHOLDING THE BOARD'S DECEMBER 1, 2016 APPROVAL OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S APPLICATION FOR **GREGORY SMITH'S** NON-DUTY DISABILITY RETIREMENT.

KASSEL JAMES – PENSION NUMBER 230565

BY TRUSTEE PEGG – SUPPORTED BY TRUSTEE DIAZ

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting on February 2, 2017, the Board of Trustees of the Police and Fire Retirement System of the City of Detroit (“PFRS”), received and reviewed correspondence from PFRS Member Kassel James, Sr. dated January 13, 2017, which included a request to instate Mr. James as a vested member based on his service from January 20, 1986 to January 15, 1996; and

WHEREAS, Mr. James accurately reports that at the time of his termination from service with the Detroit Police Department in January 1996, the vesting rule in place provided that vesting required 40 years of age with at least 8 years of service; and

WHEREAS, Mr. James reports that he separated from service with the Police Department at age 32, just 96 hours short of 10 years of service; and

WHEREAS, Mr. James reports that the vesting classification changed after the City of Detroit’s Chapter 9 bankruptcy proceedings to 10 years of service, and cites this policy change as the reason for his request; and

WHEREAS, the Board maintains the obligation to discharge fiduciary duties to PFRS pursuant to the Public Employee Retirement System Investment Act, Act 314 of 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Board is required to administer payment of benefits consistent with the terms of the Combined Plan of the Police and Fire Retirement System of the City of Detroit, Michigan, as amended December 8, 2014, effective July 1, 2014 (the “Combined Plan”); and

WHEREAS, the Board limited by the language of the Combined Plan, see Component I Section 14.1(3), to making only those benefit payments that are required as provided in the Combined Plan; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the Combined Plan do not provide authority for the Board to grant the request made by Mr. James; and the Board has considered this matter in open session, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Board respectfully denies the request made by Mr. James to be instated as a vested member based on his service rendered from January 20, 1986, to January 15, 1996, for the reason that the Board lacks the authority to grant the request; and be it further
