FOCUS LIST- OUTPERFORMERS

Wells Capital Small Cap (US Equity Investment Manager) Small Cap Growth- Wells Capital continued to outperform its index during 2Q 2020 ahead by over 7% and the top 20% of its peers during the quarter. Over the trailing one year, Wells has outperformed 70% of peer Small Cap Growth Managers.

Johnston International Equity (Non-US Equity Developed Markets) Johnston has been able to outperform in both extreme up and down markets, ahead of the index during 2Q 2020 by nearly 10%. Over the past 1, 3, and 5-year time horizons, Johnston ranks in the top 10% of peers

Loomis Sayles (Core Fixed Income) Loomis Sayles is a Core Plus Fixed Income Investment Managers in the DPFRS Portfolio. Following underperformance in Q1 2020 during the market sell-off, Loomis captured the opportunity of spread compression and riskier assets, outperforming by over 2.5% in 2Q 2020 and erasing the underperformance in 1Q. Over the past 1 year, Loomis ranks near the top 10% of peer Core Plus peers.
